The month's color is Ballet White which is not really white. It's really like cafe au lait that's 90% lait. And I thought it would be fun to pair it up with the wallpaper that's popping up just about everywhere. The Raphael by Sandberg in dark blue.

For designers, this Swedish company is ripped by Old World Weavers. If you are not in the trade, it can be acquired from a designer or probably somebody is selling it online. Please be super careful when ordering wall covering because roll sizes vary and not all "double rolls" are created equally.

In addition, since I don't have the actual sample of the wallpaper, I do not know for sure if ballet white is a good coordinate. So, please don't assume that it is. It is based on my photos. But as we all know (or should)—picking colors from a photo is a recipe for disaster.

All of the other furnishings are on other boards. What I love is that they are all on boards with different colors and feeling.

One thing about this paper and that is it needs to be broken up a lot if it's going on a big expanse of wall because in large doses will feel pretty crazy. Another way around that is to put the paper inside panel moulding with several inches of wall between panels.

And it's great to put art over the wallpaper too.
