The palette has yellows, golds, greens and a bit of that lovely orange red which is very welcome.

I've been on a retro kick and I think that I said I was going to use some other furniture, but for some reason ended up with a different look.



I found this classic Chippendale Camel Back sofa on <u>Chairish</u> for only \$1,295.00. I chose it because it is a classic style and thought it would look good with the wall color. I'm in two minds about the pattern; can't decide whether it's dated or really cool in a retro way. But I think with the Chinoiserie pillows and other furnishings it's fine.
